Macroscopical Findings of Various Exanthema — Its Character and the Shema of Developmental Mechanism —

Abstract

Clinical findings and its developmental mechanism in various exanthema were reported.

- Erythema, urticaria, exfoliative dermatitis and purpura occure as the results of pathological changes such as dilatation of the blood vessels, inflammatory changes of vascular wall (angitis) and perivascular cell infiltration.
- Pigmentation and depigmentation occure by the pathological changes of melanocyte and melanin formation.
- Nodules and sclerosis occure by increase or reduce of epidermal, collageneous or subcutaneous tissue.
- 4) Various bulla and pustules situated intraepidermally or subepidermally were shown.
- 5) Another skin changes e.g. cyst, erosion excoriation, rhagades were also demonstrated.
