## Macroscopical Findings of Various Exanthema – Its Character and the Shema of Developmental Mechanism –

### Abstract

Clinical findings and its developmental mechanism in various exanthema were reported.

- 1) Erythema, urticaria, exfoliative dermatitis and purpura occur as the results of pathological changes such as dilatation of the blood vessels, inflammatory changes of vascular wall (angitis) and perivascular cell infiltration.
- 2) Pigmentation and depigmentation occur by the pathological changes of melanocyte and melanin formation.
- 3) Nodules and sclerosis occur by increase or reduce of epidermal, collagenous or subcutaneous tissue.
- 4) Various bulla and pustules situated intraepidermally or subepidermally were shown.
- 5) Another skin changes e.g. cyst, erosion excoriation, rhagades were also demonstrated.
