アトピー性皮膚炎患者でのメイクアップ化粧品の効用

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The Usefulness of Make-up Cosmetics in Atopic Dermatitis Patients

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Abstract

The usefulness of make-up cosmetics in female patients with atopic dermatitis was studied. A less-irritable and moisturizing foundation cosmetic was used for four weeks on the face with mild to moderate degree of dermatitis. The results showed that no serious adverse reaction nor exacerbation of dermatitis was observed, and the improvement of dry skin and itch was obtained. QOL of the patients, especially in point of sensation, was also improved. Dermatologists should be more intent to learn about cosmetics and to advise properly how to use them to atopic dermatitis patients, since they do hope to hide the eruption safely and to show themselves more charming.
